ACCOMMODATION

THE OUTSTANDING BALANCE TO BE PAID BY END OF JUNE 2018.

The Convention will be held at the **SCHOENSTATT Retreat and Conference Centre**, in Constantia, Cape Town. Schoenstatt is a Catholic Convent, set in a tranquil garden, and the word Schoenstatt means “a beautiful place” in German. Should you wish to learn more about Schoenstatt and the Sisters do go onto their website : www.schoenstattconstantia.co.za/

Accommodation mainly consists of single rooms with shared ablutions; there are a limited number of shared rooms with 2 single beds and a cottage which can sleep 9 persons (4 rooms – single beds). In order to assist us in allocating rooms, please indicate with whom you would like to share a room. Bedding and hand towels are provided, but bath towels and toiletries are not.

Unfortunately it is not possible to accommodate non delegates (ie partners or husbands) at Schoenstatt as rooms are limited. Should you wish to book your own separate accommodation, there are many B&B's available in the area.

Classes will be held in various venues around the centre, as well as in the sitting room of the 9 bed cottage. Please note that delegates will need to walk from their rooms to the teaching areas and the dining room, there are no lifts.

The price is **R640.00** per person per day (single and sharing rate) which includes Dinner, Bed and Breakfast, use of teaching areas and morning and afternoon tea. Lunches will be charged separately and must be booked.

Please note that single rooms will be allocated **on a first come first serve basis and availability.**
